This booklet explains the requirements for entry to Turkey as a NON-U.S Citizen including U.S Refugees, and provides information on how to apply for a visa. Please read this booklet carefully, before you apply for a visa.

## What is a Visa?

A visa is a form issued by a visa officer. This form is placed in your passport to show that you have met the requirements for admission to Turkey. A visa may be for a single entry, for multiple entries, or for transit purposes.

There are four types of visa issued by the Turkish Consulates. These are: tourist, business, education and work visas.

The tourist visa is good for a year and allows you to stay in Turkey for 3 months in each stay (with multiple entries).

## Where and When do I apply for a Visa?

All visa applications must be made through the Turkish Consulates around the U.S. You may directly contact a Turkish Consulate in person, by mail or by a courier service. Please see the Jurisdiction List of the Turkish Consulates for your state.

All types of visa applications must be done ahead of time, before entering Turkey. Requests for education and work visas are forwarded to Turkey to get the approval of the Turkish Authorities. Therefore, applications for these visas must be submitted at least 6 weeks in advance.

Applicants without relevant visa are not allowed to study or work in Turkey.

## What are the requirements for tourist and business visas?

The followings are the general requirements for tourist and business visas. Our processing time is one-day after we receive your documents.

If the application for tourist or business visa is done through mail or by a courier service, you are required to include a pre-paid or self-stamped return envelope.

Note that neither the visa officer nor the Turkish Consulates are responsible for lost documents.

### TOURIST VISA

- 1- your passport (at least valid for the next three months).
- 2- completed visa application form and a passport size photo.
- 3- non-refundable processing fee. Please see the applicable fee at <http://www.turkey.org/consularservices/>

### BUSINESS VISA

- 1- your passport (at least valid for the next three months).
- 2- completed visa application form and a passport size photo.
- 3- non-refundable processing fee. Please see the applicable fee at <http://www.turkey.org/consularservices/>
- 4- letter from the company.

## What are the requirements for education and work visas?
